

Dear Oregon Medical Board,

My name is Alisa Wall. I am formally lodging a complaint against Dr. Darryl George. I am asking the Medical Board to investigate his abnormal behaviors and drug abuse.

I worked with Dr. Darryl George for over 2 years at a clinic in Medford called SoHemp. The clinic was run out of a house. I was initially hired as a chaperone for Dr. George that you, the Oregon Medical Board, required. I eventually ran the office doing scheduling and records. A male chaperone was hired after I no longer performed that duty. The chaperone would perform his job in flip flops and without his shirt. Individuals not related to the clinic were allowed to smoke cigarettes, drink alcohol and sleep at the clinic/house. Medical records were not secured and risked exposure to others. There were continuous HIPPA violations at the office.


Dr. George was using cocaine, even at the office. There were times that I had to tell him to wipe his nose before going into an exam room because there was white powder on it. On one occasion, I was asked by Dr. George if I wanted to use cocaine. I have smoked marijuana with Dr. George.

On one occasion, at a party, Dr. George was in a hot tub with others and was openly masturbating in front of everyone. Dr. George worked for an individual named Brent Kenyon. I observed both of these men using cocaine together. Brent Kenyon was arrested by Medford Police for selling a very large quantity of marijuana to an undercover officer in early 2008.

Another name you should be aware of is Donna Eide. She runs the AMOP Clinic in Roseburg, OR and she was intimately involved with Dr. Darryl George and Brent Kenyon.

I'm appalled that the Oregon Medical Board has allowed Dr. George to continue the practice of medicine. Please investigate this situation.
