RE: Southern Oregon Hemp & Attending Physician Dr. ██████████

I became a patient at Southern Oregon Hemp in 2005. The clinic was in an upstairs building in Medford Oregon. The clinic was very un-professional and un-organized. To ask for assistance you would have to walk to the window to see who would pop out of the smoked filled vehicle and then go back and forth upstairs. The Attending physician, Dr. ██████████ checked my vitals and heartbeat (no one else was in the room). He said nothing of a heart problem, checked my medical records, counseled me, and then filled out approval paper work. He told me he might not sign my license next time if I did not see him every 6 months.

In 2006 I again returned to Dr. ██████████ clinic. The clinic was in a large house out by Jacksonville. When you entered this house, on the left side, was a lounge area with people consuming medicine and to the right, were tables. The receptionist (who was the only one I saw doing much of anything) brought me the paperwork. I filled out the paperwork and asked about a restroom. I was given direction in which I ended up in a kitchen patio area. I walked up on 4 men around a tiled counter top on which white powder was lined up on it. I knew one was the manager. I had seen him in the smoking lounge. They immediately told me how to get to the restroom. When I returned I complained to my boyfriend who was with me about what I saw.

I was taken by the receptionist (who was also the nurse) along with my partner to see the doctor. When I saw the doctor, I realized he was one of the 4 men in the kitchen. He was the one wiping off his nose when I came in kitchen. He examined me and checked my heart. He immediately startled everyone by gasping out did I know how bad my heart was. I replied that I had a heart murmur as a child, but no problems or even mention of the murmur as an adult. He finished his exam, checked my medical records and paperwork and told me he would sign my license but, if I did not see him every 4 months he would no longer sign my license. I told him I could not afford that. I left Southern Oregon Hemp. I requested my medical records but, never received them. I currently go through a very reliable clinic and would never return to Southern Oregon Hemp or Doctor ██████████.

I would like the Oregon Medical Board to investigate this doctor. He should not be allowed to practice medicine in this state. Please contact me about this situation.
