On Thursday, one of the St. Louis Battlehawks' training staff members died suddenly at the team hotel.

The professional American football team based in St. Louis, Missouri announced that Ben Siegfried, who worked with the XFL Athletic Training Department, passed away.

"The XFL family mourns the loss of our teammate, Ben Siegfried, who passed away last evening," the team wrote on Twitter Friday.

"Ben, a graduate student athletic trainer from Lebanon Valley College working with the XL Athletic Training Department, was an integral part of preparing our Battlehawks and Defenders for the season. His infectious smile in the locker room and passion for his work will be deeply missed by all the players and staff who had the opportunity to work with him. Our thoughts and prayers are with his family and friends," the post continued.

Details regarding the cause of death have not yet been released.

According to FOX2Now, Ben Siegfried was in his early 20s when he passed away.

Numerous personalities have taken to social media to pay tribute to Siegfried.

"So so sorry to hear this devastating news come in earlier today. Sending strength, love, light, and mana to the Siegfried family during this heartbreaking time. We are with you. Stay strong," Hollywood actor Dwayne Johnson aka "The Rock."

"Our thoughts and prayers go out to the Siegfried family," said XFL Battlehawks Head Coach Anthony Becht. "Ben was a passionate person and a bright light everyday since we started the season back in January. He was a special part of the Battlehawks family and he will be sorely missed. Hugged his mom and brother today."

28-Year-Old Rapper Dies Suddenly on Stage During Music Festival

Earlier this month, a young fighter suffered a medical emergency during a fight at The Coliseum in downtown Evansville, Indiana.

Amateur MMA fighter Isaiah Abels, 21, was rushed to the hospital after suffering a cardiac arrest shortly after landing a second-round takedown during a fight, Express **reported**.

Medical personnel rushed in and were able to restart Abels' heart before he was taken to the hospital.

According to the doctors, Isaiah experienced brain damage due to a lack of oxygen to his brain for several minutes.

Abels' brother Zach posted an emotional message on Facebook explaining how the incident occurred during the second round after he landed a takedown.

Last night Isaiah Abels engaged in battle. It went two rounds. First round went to him with beautiful striking. The fight transitioned into the second round. Isaiah continued to pick his shots and maintained his pace and distance.

Unexpectedly he was countered with a lead hook. He responded with a takedown and continued to pressure his opponent against the fence to recover from the hook. Isaiah then disengaged from the clinch and went to press forward. As he continued to pressure his opponent something ominous happened.

Isaiah took a step forward and collapsed to his knees. He was going into respiratory arrest. Soon after the fight was stopped. The ref had no idea what really happened thinking it was a typical stoppage. Clearly it wasn't. Isaiah wasn't getting up because he was also going into cardiac arrest.

Once the doctors and medics accessed the situation. They got his heart going as they assisted his breathing. We rushed to the hospital. A hour or so later Isaiah was stabilized.

I don't know what you believe in, but the fear of God was put into all of us last night. Words can't even describe. I'm grateful for everyone praying and thinking about him, but I really wanna thank the medical professionals along with God. Again, I don't know to what degree you believe in God, but please continue to keep Isaiah in your thoughts and prayers.

Please, God. Please everyone. Please. I love you, Isaiah Lee

Doctors are Baffled After 17-Year-Old Girl Suffered Cardiac Arrest While at a Cheer Competition

Last week, a healthy and active 17-year-old girl suddenly suffered a cardiac arrest during a cheer competition, leading to multiple seizures.

Keianna Joe had a seizure and stopped breathing after suffering a cardiac arrest while in warmups at a competition in Raleigh, North Carolina.

"I need everyone to pray for my beautiful girl. At a cheer competition today she had a seizure and stopped breathing. She is in the pediatric ICU now intubated and still unresponsive. We need the prayer chain to start her healing," Keianna's mother, Andrea Joe wrote on her Facebook account.

Andrea said that they still do not know what caused the seizure, but they suspect at first that it was caused by her not eating and consuming a Red Bull, as well as the "stimulation of cheer caused her heart to go into arrhythmia, triggering multiple seizures."

On her Facebook account, Andrea gave a detailed description of what had happened.

"While in warmups at a competition in Raleigh, she was coming down from a stunt when she started acting "weird." They got her to the ground gently and her coach noticed her flexing with her eyes rolled back. There was another coach there who happened to be a [registered nurse] came to her side and realized immediately she was not breathing, checked for a pulse and started CPR. Thank you from the bottom of my heart for being there. I then got to my daughters side felt for a pulse and did not find one so I took over CPR. I did 3-4 rounds of CPR placed the AED and gave 1 shock. Then a grandfather from our gym took over with CPR. She started breathing on her own at that time but still unresponsive. Paramedics brought her to the hospital where she had 3 more seizures and coded so they intubated her. At this time she is still intubated but stable. We are not 100% sure what caused this but believe her not eating, drinking a Red Bull and the stimulation of cheer caused her heart to go into Arrhythmia triggering multiple seizures. I want to thank the coach who started CPR and the grandfather who took over CPR for me and the entire cheer family who came to the hospital tonight. No words can say how thankful I am. Now we just pray for my beautiful girl to wake up and get back to her normal feisty self." "While at the hospital, Keianna had 3 more seizures and coded once again, so the decision was made to intubate her. At the time of this post, she is still in a medically induced coma in the ICU but is stable," **according** to a fundraising campaign.

"We are unsure exactly what caused this incident, and can only speculate that her heart went into arrhythmia from a combination of dehydration, too much caffeine from an energy drink, and exercise," the campaign reads.

Andrea gave another update and said that Keianna had a severe cardiac arrest that triggered seizures, and it was not the result of not drinking a Red Bull.

She added that they might have to put an implantable cardiac defibrillator (ICD) in Keianna.

"So today her recovery process took a huge turn in a different direction. We received the results from the AED that was used to shock her and learned her heart was in ventricular fibrillation which is why shock

was given. So this being said she didn't just have a seizure she had a severe cardiac arrest which triggered seizures. Due to this new diagnosis, she was transferred to Duke to be followed by some of the best pediatric cardiac doctors in the nation. Originally the ONKY thing we could relate this to was her not eating and drinking a Red Bull. We have been informed that this was NOT caused by those two things alone. (Although it is still very bad to not eat drink a Red Bull and compete) these were not very big factors. I was told that the quick response by her coaches and the immediate CPR starting is why she is recovering so fast because it kept all her organs working her heart would have never recovered from this rhythm without the use of the AED. She is struggling coming to terms with the news that CHEER and track are over for her as these were her true passion. She is still in fairly good spirits being sassy and making me laugh with all her hilarious comments. I am still trying to wrap my brain around the news that my 17-year-old athletic daughter had a severe heart attack. She still has a very long road ahead with multiple Dr visits so I am asking for everyone to continue and pray for her healing as well as her peace of mind. They are planning on placing an internal defibrillator in her after the results of more MRIs and other stress tests come in. Thank you from the bottom of my heart for the prayer and well wishes it is truly felt and I am overwhelmed by the support and love everyone has shown."

On Saturday, Andrea said her daughter had an MRI that ruled out heart abnormalities, which includes "ruling out any COVID vaccine as being a contributing factor." The doctors have no idea what caused her to have a heart attack.

Doctors were suspecting a **long QT syndrome**, also called a heart conduction disorder, a heart signaling disorder that can cause fast, chaotic heartbeats (arrhythmias).

"She has continued to improve with her short-term memory loss. She has been at Duke University Hospital for 3 days and is doing about as well as a 17-year-old stuck in a hospital room should. They have run so many different tests on her I lost count but the most recent was a heart MRI which came back normal ruling out any abnormalities. This includes ruling out any covid vaccine as being a contributing factor. Yes, I had a very long discussion with her cardiac team and we are exploring EVERY possibility. Her Echo and EKG are normal. She did a stress test today where she ran on a treadmill. (Funny story, when the Dr asked if she was feeling like she could tolerate a treadmill she responded with, "I run for fun, I can't wait let's go."). That came back with just a slight arrhythmia but nothing that they would think to cause the sudden cardiac arrest in a healthy active 17-year-old. They have been discussing something that is called long QT Syndrome. (Look it up it's too long to explain.). Because as of now this is what they call idiopathic cardiac arrest or in better terms, they have no clue why she had a cardiac arrest, they will be placing an ICD device in her on Monday. This will continue to monitor her rhythm at all times and if needed will give an emergency shock to the heart. She is in agreement that this is the best thing for her at this time, I told her it was either this device or I go wherever she goes at all times including school in case I need to do CPR again. That made the decision really easy. But seriously thank you is just not enough to express how eternally grateful we are that she is still here today. It is something like only 17% of people who go into sudden cardiac arrest with VFib survive if happened outside an emergency care facility. That is not a very high percent and this beautiful sassy brilliant girl is living proof God is the one in control and has bigger plans for this child."

29-Year-Old South African Footballer Dies Suddenly After Collapsing in Training

South African footballer Siphamandla 'Spepe' Mtolo, a midfielder for Richards Bay FC in South Africa's top division, died suddenly on Tuesday after collapsing in training.

"It is with deep sadness to announce that Richards Bay Football club has untimely lost one of the midfielders, Siphamandla 'Spepe' Mtolo he collapsed this morning during training," the team announced on Twitter.

Details regarding the cause of death have not yet been released.

"The club is not in a position to provide further information at this stage and as that his family's privacy is respected in this difficult time of bereavement."

"His presence both on and off the pitch will be solely missed. Thoughts and prayers of everyone in Richards Bay Football Club are with his family, friends and love ones." the post continued.

South Africa's professional football governing body, the Premier Soccer League, also released a statement on Twitter.

"The PSL is deeply saddened by the untimely passing of Richards Bay Football Club midfielder, Siphamandla Mtolo. A moment of silence will be observed in his honour at this week's Nedbank Cup and DSTv Diski Challenge fixtures. May his soul repose peacefully," the post reads.

Mtolo's funeral service was held on Sunday, March 12th.

Club officials, technical team and players have arrived at Nkobongo Sports Ground, Shakaskraal to pay their respects at the funeral service of the late Siphamandla "Spepe" Mtolo.

Teen with No Previous Medical Conditions Dies After 'Cardiac Arrest' During PE

An English teenager is dead after suffering what was termed a cardiac arrest during gym class. Kayla Ere suffered a medical emergency on March 2 at The Gateway Academy in Essex, according to the Daily Mirror. The Mirror said the school described Ere as a “lovely student.

No previous medical conditions – suddenly she passed due to a cardiac arrest. Words cannot describe this tragedy!” Anita Singh wrote on a Just Giving page she set up seeking cash for the 14-year-old girl’s family.

“The mother left behind has lost her world,” Singh wrote.

She wrote that Ere’s single mother “requires financial support. We would like to come together as a community to raise funds for the funeral of Kayla Ere. “This Angel of God deserves a great send-off,” she wrote.

A Gateway Academy representative explained the incident.

“Following the medical emergency at The Gateway Academy on Thursday, March 2 involving a student who became very unwell in a PE lesson it is with great sadness that we inform our community that she died in hospital,” according to the Gazette-Standard.

“The medical team at the Gateway Academy, paramedics and doctors worked tirelessly to support the student before the air ambulance transferred her to King’s College hospital,” the representative said. The representative said school officials went to the hospital along with family members.

The Mirror said that in a message to the school and community, Francesca Ere, Kayla’s mother, thanked the members of the school community for their support.

“This pain cannot leave me in the near future but with the kind support am receiving from everyone all I want to say is am very proud of the impact my little girl had made in her short life lived and the few years she had spent in Gateway Academy,” she wrote.

“Kayla was a great child and she had made me a proud mother and also impacted so many lives, thank you to all the lovely students for your cards, sweet messages from her friends, parents and kids from other years,” she wrote.

“I am so grateful and appreciate your prayers, love, care. I know that I can’t reach each and everyone of you physically or personally but know that I really appreciate your support/prayers and I know it’s helping me heal. God bless you all.”

19-Year-Old National Guard Soldier Dies Suddenly After Completing a Two-Mile Run Fitness Test

A junior soldier in the Oklahoma National Guard died earlier this month after a physical fitness test at the McAlester Army Ammunition Plant in McAlester, Oklahoma.

On March 4, Spc. Jaykob R. Pruitt, 19, from Bennington, Oklahoma, collapsed and died after completing the two-mile run portion of the Army Combat Fitness Test (ACFT).

"A 19-year-old Specialist assigned to the Army National Guard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on Title 32 drill status died in an on-duty sports, recreation and physical training mishap 4 March 2023 in McAlester, Oklahoma, at 1045 local. After completing the 2-mile run portion of the Army Combat Fitness Test, the Soldier walked away from the track, fell to the ground and was found unresponsive," according to a **preliminary loss report** published by the service.

CPR was performed, and the emergency medical services (EMS) were called. Pruitt was taken by ambulance to the hospital, where he was declared dead.

"Since 2018, the Army has lost an average of one Soldier a year to on-duty sports, recreation and physical training mishaps. This was the third on-duty sports, recreation and physical training mishap of FY23 and above the number of on-duty sports, recreation and physical training fatalities from this time last year," the report added.

SPC Pruitt enlisted in the Oklahoma Army National Guard on October 21, 2020. He then joined B Troop as a Cavalry Scout after completing his training at Fort Benning, GA in October 2021, per Oklahoma National Guard Retirees.

Funeral services to honor Jaykob were held on Saturday, March 11, 2023, at 12:00 PM at the Bennington High School Gymnasium.

"Our thoughts and prayers are with Jaykob's family, friends and our fellow Soldiers," said Maj. Gen. Thomas H. Mancino, adjutant general for Oklahoma. "Together, we are mourning the devastating loss of a promising young man and Soldier."

TRAGIC: 37-Year-Old Italian Swimmer Reportedly Took His Own Life After a Long Period of Suffering Due to COVID Vaccine Reaction

Claudio Rais, a personal trainer, swimming champion, and a man full of dreams, died at the age of 37. Mr. Rais reportedly took his own life by jumping off the Rosello Bridge, the highest and most important bridge in the city of Sassari in Italy, according to Swim for Life Magazine.

Rais was struggling with his health after he suffered an adverse reaction following his third dose of the COVID vaccine on February 10, 2022, a Moderna dose after the first two Pfizers, Alghero Live reported.



Claudio's Facebook page was filled with uplifting and motivational posts about his passion for coaching others and swimming until he began experiencing negative side effects from the COVID vaccine.

On July 30, 2022, Claudio wrote on his Facebook page about his health problem.

"I wanted to thank you all for your support and concern towards me in these difficult days. I had so many calls and messages and it was honestly much appreciated. Unfortunately, not everything is up to us. Sometimes you have to deal with adverse and alas, totally unexpected situations. I can guarantee you not knowing what's really going on and having to deal with a health care system to say the least certainly doesn't help reassure people. Health is the most precious gift we have in life, I didn't discover this today but it will and will always be the front page of my coming days. On the other hand, hope and will to live fully and take the situation in my hands, I hope it will give me the strength to face the path in this hostile moment..."

On September 28, 2022, Claudio wrote a lengthy post describing his ordeal about the COVID-19 vaccine reactions.

[Translation] But how do you still allow yourself ...? ... are you really so presumptuous as to seriously think that a person who has dedicated all of himself to sports, physical activity, and the well-being of himself

and others ... can stop everything from one day to the next and spend thousands of euros on visits of all kinds because he is dreaming of being unwell? I was damaged by a reaction that together with the effects of COVID has created very serious neurological and physiological damage that is literally PREVENTING me from living a normal and respectful life.

From the outside you can't and can never understand but that doesn't mean you're allowed to shoot sentences without any restraint. If it were really as some of you claim there would have been no problem admitting it.

"The fact is that it's not like that unfortunately and I stress UNFORTUNATELY ... because I have proof of it every second that passes... and I with the little strength and lucidity that I have left ... I am desperately trying to find the life that has been taken from me and I will do it as long as my heart beats. Many in my place would have already put a rope around their necks without thinking twice. My situation is getting worse with more and more frightening symptoms that I don't know how I can stand yet. Joints, skin, organs and especially cognitive deficits to be compared to those of severe brain trauma. Sensitivity, cognition, thermoregulation, balance, sight, appetite, thirst, impulses, desires, organic functionalities, emotions, perceptions, pain...in a word...LIFE!"

"I'm scared, I can't find a remedy even though I unfortunately think there won't be much to do...hope is the last to die, but dignity can't be trampled on either. So please, put one hand on your conscience and the other on your heart and since you can't understand what really happened, that I've lived and am living, at least have the common sense not to judge. I hope these words of mine have served to understand at least in part the damage I have suffered. Fortunately, there are so many people who have never doubted a single moment and who support me in this exhausting war. My thanks are for you, for those who know me seriously."

On the same day, Claudio was looking for a vascular surgeon for a brain biopsy – angio-RM.

On December 6, 2022, Claudio posted a statement on Facebook, suggesting that he had already given up due to the complications he was experiencing with his health.

"Ends here, ends today... Fate wanted my life to be totally stripped of its essence. One in a billion cases, maybe not even... it's my turn. I'd rather walk away and not burden anyone but especially not burden myself for the rest of my days. I thank God for everything he has given me every single day of these years and all the wonderful people he has brought me to meet. Now all I can do is swim freely in the clouds. I hope I will stay forever in your hearts," he wrote.

On December 25th, Claudio was able to send everybody a Christmas message, "Wishing you the most precious gift one can receive in life: HEALTH. Thank you and Merry Christmas my friends."

One of Claudio's closest friends debunked the claim that he died of a heart attack, according to Zone D' Ombra.

[Translation] "I'm reading absurd things from the newspapers in my city and region. Claudio was sick a year ago after the third dose, you read the symptoms you had, this also prevented him from participating last summer in the swimming teams in Rome, prevented him from doing his job as a personal trainer and prevented him from being able to get out of bed. He has been almost a year doing paid visits also to try to understand what he had or what his bad was due to but no one knew or I hypothesized to give him an answer a cure or a solution and in the meantime it has worsened but it is known that this on collateral damage is an uncomfortable truth. **The consequence of all this came this morning, as painful as it is to write it, he took his own life but the truth is that his real life for those like me other friends and family knew him, had already lost it for some time.** He was a sportsman who in our community gave a hand to young and old with his knowledge of fitness and swimming. He was a golden boy."

35-Year-Old Multi-Year World Cup Medalist Dies Unexpectedly

Angel Fournier Rodriguez, Cuba's most successful rower in history, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, March 16 in Texas where he had recently moved. He was 35.

The news of his sudden passing was announced by World Rowing, which read, "World Rowing is saddened to hear of the passing of Cuban rower Angel Fournier Rodriguez."

"Fournier Rodriguez was a multiple-time World Cup medallist, Pan Am Champion, and 2x time Olympian"

"We wish to extend our condolences to Angel's family and the Cuban Federation," the post concluded.

No details have been released on the cause of death.

21-Year-Old Irish Cricket Player Dies "Within Days of Cancer Diagnosis" - Oncologist Believes Increase in Testicular Cancer Cases May Be Vaccine Related

Last week, a bowler from Ireland was diagnosed with testicular cancer after experiencing dizziness in the gym. On Monday morning, the County Down bowler passed away.

As reported by the **Belfast Telegraph**:

Tributes have been paid to a young Co Down bowler who died days after being diagnosed with testicular cancer.

Daniel Donnan from Donaghadee was taken to hospital after he suddenly fell ill towards the end of last week.

It's understood he experienced a dizzy spell in the gym and numbness down one side of his body.

The 21-year-old was rushed to the Ulster Hospital where he was treated for a bleed to the brain, but medical tests revealed tumours which had already spread to his brain and lungs.

Dr. William Makis, a nuclear medicine radiologist at the Cross Cancer Institute, **published a substack** over the weekend that raised questions about a sudden onslaught of testicular cancer cases among young, otherwise healthy athletes and other physically fit men.

In Dr. Makis's **piece**, he points out a "**fact check**" that COVID-19 vaccines cause testicular cancer. The fact check, of course, denies any relation between testicular cancer and the experimental jab, but does concede there were four German footballers in the first league that have gotten testicular cancer since 2022. Dr. Makis points to another article claiming that number is as high as 14. 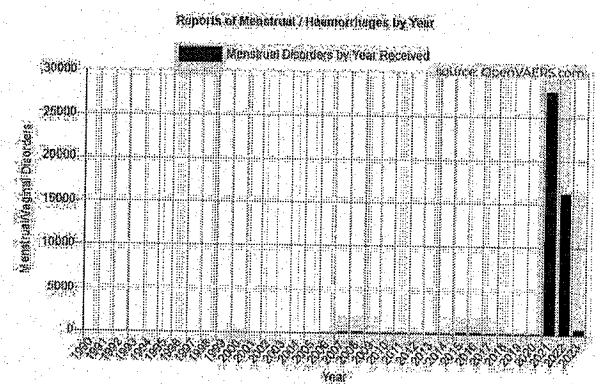
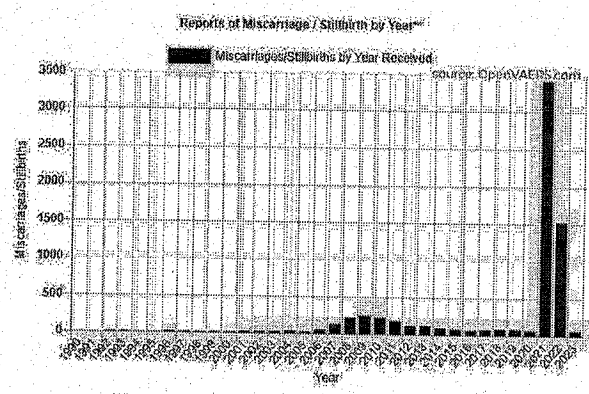

29-Year-Old MIT Professor Suddenly Drops Dead While Playing Basketball on Campus

A young math instructor at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology died suddenly on campus last month while he was playing basketball, the school has announced.

According to [MIT News](#), applied mathematics teacher Peter Baddoo was on a campus basketball court in Cambridge, [Massachusetts](#), on Feb. 15 when he collapsed.

The university offered few details about the incident, other than to note the 29-year-old died “suddenly” and unexpectedly.

“Peter Baddoo, an instructor in the Department of Mathematics, passed away suddenly on Feb. 15 while playing basketball on campus,” the report from MIT News stated.

It is not clear if Baddoo had any underlying medical conditions.

No cause of death is available at this time.

[Badoo](#) had been a part of the faculty since 2021, [the school](#) said in a statement.

“Baddoo joined the MIT Department of Mathematics in January 2021,” the statement said. “Prior to this, he was an [\[Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council\]](#) Doctoral Prize Fellow at Imperial College London.”

Baddoo studied mathematics in his native country, the U.K. He received his undergraduate degree there at the University of Oxford and his Ph.D. from Cambridge University in [England](#).

Should an investigation be done into the slew of "died suddenly" deaths across America?

The young scholar made the move to New England, where he specialized in the fields of “complex function theory, fluid dynamics, and machine learning.”

Professor Michel Goemans, the head of the university’s math department, remembered Baddoo for his ability to connect with [students](#).

“Peter was an excellent lecturer — clear, composed, thoughtful, and kind. He was extremely popular among his students,” Goemans said.

One student told the school paper Baddoo’s passion for [mathematics](#) actually inspired him to pursue studying the field.

“I took Peter’s class, and I walked out of that class actually liking math,” said the student, who was not named. “I was assured that I want to study more of math and pursue a minor.”

Professor John Bush also memorialized [his late colleague](#) in a statement.

Ashley Kertes, Wife of Westmoreland County Commissioner, Dies 'Unexpectedly' at 36

The wife of a Republican Westmoreland County Commissioner Sean Kertes, Ashley Kertes, was found dead on Friday morning. She was 36.

Greensburg Mayor Robb Bell said that Kertes was found unresponsive in bed at her home at around 7:30 a.m., **Trib Live** reported.

Details regarding the cause of death have not yet been released.

According to officials, no foul play is suspected.

"It is so profoundly sad. Ashley is one of the most talented and brightest stars in the city," Mayor Robb Bell said.

County controller Balzer said that on Thursday night, Kertes spoke to a crowd of several hundred who had gathered to support her husband at a political fundraiser at Rizzo's Malabar Inn in Crabtree.

"She got up in front of the room and introduced everybody," Balzer said.

Trib Live reported:

Kertes worked as the associate administrator to the superintendent and community outreach in the Greensburg Salem School District. She previously worked for **four years as the executive director of the Greensburg Community Development Corporation** and at the courthouse in Westmoreland County's fiscal department and Controller's Office.

Kertes is the daughter of North Huntingdon District Judge Wayne Gongaware. Her mother works at the courthouse as a court assistant.

Greensburg Salem Superintendent Ken Bissell said the school district is grieving her loss.

"Ashley is a beautiful, kind and caring person who did so much in such a short time with Greensburg Salem. We are deeply saddened," Bissell said.

While working for the city's nonprofit development agency, Kertes headed the creation of several initiatives including the covid-19 **Relief Main Street Jump-Start Program**, which aimed to help small businesses in the city struggling because of the pandemic. She also spearheaded Greensburg Restaurant Week events and the Hometown Hero Banner and Celebration programs.

In an interview last year with the Tribune-Review, Kertes said the jump-start program was among her proudest accomplishments.

"It not only helped them bounce back from covid, but it helped them sustain their business for the future," Kertes said.

She and her husband married in 2017. They have no children.

Utah State Wide Receiver Josh Davis Suffers Sudden Cardiac Arrest During Practice

On Friday, Utah State revealed that football player Josh Davis suffered a “non-traumatic sudden cardiac arrest” on Thursday during practice.

Davis, a wide receiver for Utah State, had a medical emergency during practice at Maverik Stadium and was taken to Logan Regional Hospital.

He was initially reported to be in critical condition, but his condition was upgraded to fair the following morning, according to ESPN.

According to Utah State, Davis was “taken off life-sustaining medical devices and is breathing on his own.”

Josh Davis, a football player for Utah state, has been upgraded from critical to fair condition as of Friday morning, following a non-traumatic sudden cardiac arrest during Thursday’s spring practice on Merlin Olsen Field at Maverick stadium.

Davis, who is currently in the intensive care unit at McKay Dee Hospital in Ogden, has been taken off life-sustaining medical devices and is breathing on his own.

Davis, a redshirt freshman wide receiver from Carlsbad, California, collapsed during practice on Thursday and was immediately treated by USU’s athletic training staff, led by Mike Williams, associate athletics Director for sports medicine, followed by emergency medical personnel, who transported him to Logan regional hospital.

Davis received initial critical treatment and was stabilized at Logan regional hospital before being transported to McKay-Dee Hospital, where their critical care team continued treatment with therapeutic hypothermia to lower the body temperature to preserve his neurological function.

Davis’ parents, Matt and Chrissy, arrived in Utah Thursday evening, and were met at the hospital by Utah State team physician Dr. David G. Liddle, interim athletic director Jerry Bovee, head football coach Blake Anderson, and athletic trainer Kendra Gilmore.

Davis is “awake, alert, and breathing on his own,” Anderson said, via Utah State football play-by-play radio voice Scott Garrard per [Si.com](https://www.si.com).

He added, “The training staff absolutely saved his life. No hesitation at all. Miracle.”

Spanish Third-Division Match Suspended After World Cup Star's Brother Suffers Cardiac Arrest During First Half

A Spanish third-division match between Cordoba and Racing de Ferrol was suspended on Saturday after Serbian defender Dragisa Gudelj suffered a cardiac arrest and collapsed on the pitch.

Dragisa Gudelj, the brother of Serbia midfielder Nemanja Gudelj who plays for Sevilla, suffered a cardiac arrest during the 11th minute of the first half.

An ambulance immediately responded and drove onto the field to assist Gudelj, and then transported him to a nearby hospital once his condition had stabilized.

Doctors performed CPR on the field and successfully revived Gudelj. They treated him for seven minutes, including cardiac massage, until the ambulance arrived, **according** to Marca.

The stars of Cordoba broke down in tears as they witnessed one of their own get medical attention.

The center-back was conscious when he was taken away in an ambulance, and the fans gave him a standing ovation as he left the stadium.

After he regained consciousness, the **25-year-old player** seemed determined to continue despite the scary incident, but he was taken to Reina Sofia hospital for observation.

The club later said that Gudelj is "stable" but under "close surveillance" in the ICU.

[Translation] Dragisa Gudelj is "stable" after being treated at the Emergency Department of the Reina Sofia University Hospital, according to the entity. However, the center-back "is going to go to the UCI for close surveillance," according to the press department.

The CEO of Córdoba, Javier González Calvo, confirmed after the meeting that the player arrived "conscious and stable" at the hospital and that he was going to be "tested" throughout the evening. "He's been in cardiac arrest for a while," although "by the time he left the stadium he was fully conscious" and "wanted to play the game."

"We have decided that, as is normal, they will take him away. In the next few hours we will give more news about Dragi, which we all hope will recover as soon as possible," he added.

Football Star Zé Carlos Collapses on Field During Match, Then Collapses Again On the Sideline (VIDEO)

In the early hours of this Thursday, Ferroviário's advisory spoke about the player. He is conscious and underwent tests, which did not indicate anything serious. Afterwards, he was medicated to ease the pain and would later be released.

Zé Carlos had suffered a shock earlier in the game, in the 13th minute of the second stage, in which he was also quickly unconscious. On the occasion, he got up shortly after with medical care and continued in the match, being substituted in the 25th minute.

Two minutes after the substitution, the left-back felt bad on the bench and players from both teams asked for an ambulance to enter. The athlete was carried on a stretcher to the vehicle, where he received care.

23-Year-Old Man left Permanently Blind from AstraZeneca COVID-19 Vaccine—Files Lawsuit in Manitoba, Canada

A new lawsuit in Canada charges that a COVID-19 vaccine injury left a 23-year-old young man legally blind. As a consequence Jackson Troy Reimer and his parents from Manitoba have filed a lawsuit in the Court of King's Bench in Steinbach, just southeast of Winnipeg. After receiving the COVID-19 vaccine Jackson had a stroke which left him legally blind. Defendants in the case: AstraZeneca Canada, Verity Pharmaceuticals (manufacturers of COVIDSHIELD), Vail Resorts (his employer), the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority (administered the vaccine) and the Attorney General of Canada. The plaintiff's legal theory in this case: All of the defendants owed a duty of care to represent the actual risks associated with the COVID-19 vaccines.

What vaccine and why?

The young man during March 2021, was employed at Whistler mountain at the Vail Resorts company in the British Columbia ski area. He and other employees living in staff housing received an email from the company recommending they receive the AstraZeneca vaccine.

In the lawsuit claim the plaintiffs describe that the company email omitted any risks associated with the AstraZeneca vaccine also known as COVISHIELD. Importantly it was finally determined by America's regulatory apparatus not to use the AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine to the south.

As reported by Danton Unger at *CTVNews* Winnipeg Reimer decided to get the vaccine from Vancouver Coastal Health Authority at a vaccine center set up in a local conference center in Whistler. However just under a week later the young man experienced some concerning symptoms from dizziness and loss of vision to severe headaches according to the lawsuit's claim. The 23-year-old was taken to Whistler Health Care Center and then to Vancouver General Hospital for a CT scan and neurological assessment.

The Condition

According to the lawsuit's claim "The results of the CT scan showed that Jackson experienced an intracerebral hemorrhage, which is also known as a hemorrhagic stroke." The lawsuit ties the vaccination with AstraZeneca's COVID-19 vaccine with the stroke, craniotomy and all the symptoms.

Now legally blind, the young man experiences memory loss, brain seizures, excessive weight gain, loss of athletic ability and even obsessive-compulsive disorder tendencies along with numerous other mental impairments writes Danton Unger for the *CTVNews* piece.

CTVNews reports that to date such a claim hasn't been tested in the courts and thus far no statements from the defense have been filed. The defendants however have 20 days to file a statement of defense in Manitoba; for those served in Canada or the US. has 40 days; any of the defendants outside both Canada and America have 60 days.

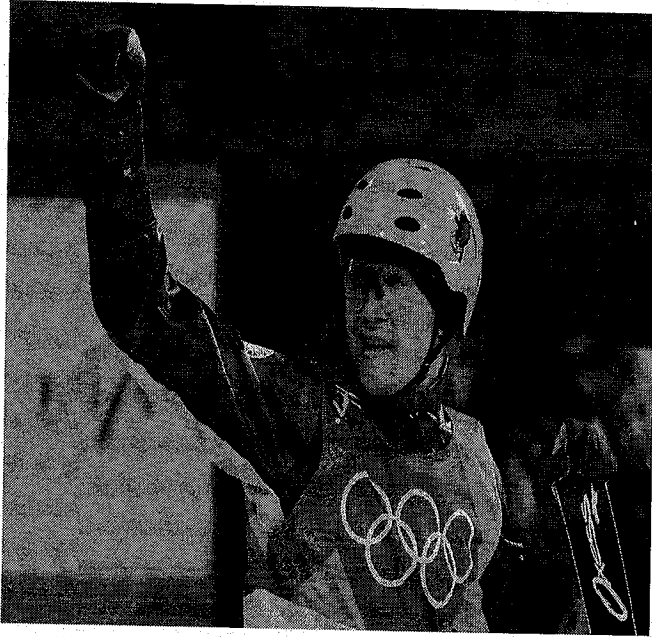

Russia's double Olympic freestyle skier Krotov dies suddenly at 30

Russia's double Olympic freestyle skier Pavel Krotov has died suddenly aged 30 after suffering a brain haemorrhage.

Krotov was in the team that won the mixed team aerials gold medals at the 2021 Freestyle Ski World Championships in Almaty.

Russian national team head coach Alexander Pongilsky said Krotov died in his sleep.

It is understood the skier would have required immediate emergency treatment to have any chance of survival.

"Many people remember Pavel as a friendly, personable and courageous person," the Russian Freestyle Federation said.

"We express our deep and sincere condolences to the family, relatives and colleagues of Pavel Krotov."

Krotov was born in Yaroslavl in April 1992 and specialised in the aerials.

He represented his country at their home Sochi Winter Olympics in 2014, but failed to qualify for the final.

At the Pyeongchang 2018 Winter Olympics he missed out on a medal by one place.

Krotov made his World Championships debut as a teenager but enjoyed his greatest success at the 2021 event in Almaty, Kazakhstan.

As well as helping the team to gold in the aerials, he won solo bronze.

He also secured two individual World Cup wins and is survived by his wife and their son.

In a statement, the International Ski and Snowboard Federation (FIS) said: "FIS would like to extend its deepest condolences to the family, friends and loved ones of Pavel."

Beauty queen dies suddenly after 'collapsing' at soccer star's stable

A young woman with "no health problems" has died suddenly at the stables, owned by a UK football legend, where she worked.

A former British beauty queen has died suddenly at work, leaving friends and family devastated.

Jessica Whalley, 25, could not be revived by paramedics after collapsing at Manor House Stables in Cheshire, northwestern England, where she worked as a transport manager.

The stables where Ms Whalley worked are owned by iconic England soccer star Michael Owen.

The 43-year-old football legend was said to have broken down "in tears" on Tuesday after the shocking death at the stables he co-owns with daughter Gemma, 19, *The Sun* reports.

Emergency services rushed to the racing yard after Ms Whalley fell ill around 8.50am, but she was tragically pronounced dead at the scene, police said.

Officers said the death is not being treated as suspicious and her next of kin have been informed.

Ms Whalley, known by pals as Jess, represented the UK in the Miss Tourism Universe pageant in 2019, which was screened on MTV and held in Beirut.

She made it into to final ten contestants.

Ms Whalley's friends Maxine Bowley and Jo Neesam both yesterday changed their Facebook profiles to photos with her and messages of condolences flooded their pages.

In a statement yesterday, Cheshire Police said: "At around 8.50am today, Tuesday 28 March, police were made aware that a 25-year-old woman had collapsed at a stables on Old Coach Road, Malpas.

"Emergency services attended the location and, despite the best efforts of all those involved, the woman sadly died at the scene.

"The death is not being treated as suspicious and her next of kin have been informed. A file will be prepared for the coroner."

Jessica Mair wrote on Facebook: "So sad seeing him [Michael Owen] and all his staff in tears today .. after such a shock to them .. such a young age.

"No health problems 25 is no age .. life really is too short for we never really know how long we have .. thoughts go out to her family and friends."

George McGrath, CEO of the National Association of Racing Staff, described Miss Whalley as "much loved".

He said: "Jessica had worked in Newmarket for a time. She had gone to rejoin Hugo Palmer in Cheshire.

"She was a much loved and respected member of the racing community and taken from us at much too early in age."

Jockey Zander Voy added: "It's heartbreaking to hear Jess lost her life today at the tender age of 25."

Ms Whalley also worked for Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, deputy ruler of Dubai, UAE, who owns a large international network of thoroughbred stables.

In 2018, she posted a photo of the Gulf state. She wrote: "I cannot wait for this to be home for the next 6 months."

In official documents published by the Office of the Traffic Commissioner this month, she is listed as one of the transport managers at Manor House Stables.

The last photo ever taken of Ms Whalley has since emerged and shows the former beauty queen smiling just 72 hours before she died.

In the snap, shared by a friend in the tragic aftermath of her passing, Ms Whalley can be seen smiling at bar holding a glass of wine.

Alongside the pic the friend wrote: "It's heartbreaking to hear Jess lost her life today at the tender age of 25.

"She was riding out doing what she loved. We had so many great times working in Dubai."

34-Year-Old Border Patrol Intel Agent Dies Suddenly Due to "Unexpected and Sudden Heart Attack"

Border Patrol Intel Agent Jose "Merc" Mercado died suddenly on Saturday due to an "unexpected and sudden heart attack." He was 34.

The news of his death was confirmed by Representative Mayra Flores (TX 34th District) in a social media post.

"My sincerest condolences to the family and friends of Border Patrol Intel Agent, Jose Mercado. He was assigned to RGV Sector in Edinburg, Texas. He passed away yesterday of a sudden heart attack. Keep his family in your prayers," Flores wrote on her Twitter, which was shared by Representative Chip Roy (R-TX 21st District).

Jose Mercado was a member of Class 875 out of **US Border Patrol RGV Sector**. He served with the US Border Patrol as an outstanding Agent for 14 years.

A fundraising campaign was created by Veronica Medina to support the Mercado family during their time of need.

At the time of writing, the fundraising had raised \$11,285 of the \$20,000 goal.

the time of authorization. There is no excuse for this delay especially given the concerns with myocarditis," Witczak told The Epoch Times via email.

"If safety was a top priority, the FDA would have denied the request and demanded this study instead of quietly allowing the extension. Where's the transparency the public was promised? It makes me wonder if the company doesn't like the data they are seeing and need to figure out a way to report on the findings," she added. "Hopefully, the documents obtained by FOIA will shine a light on the reason."

With regards to Zoloft, an antidepressant made by Pfizer, she noted that internal company correspondence revealed in her legal case against the company over her husband's suicide after starting to use Zoloft showed the company discussing whether to give the FDA a "simple straight-forward report" or "a complicated and confusing one" on adverse events after Zoloft.

Pfizer was concerned about how the FDA would interpret the data, and discussed "do[ing] some sort of review and put[ting] our interpretation into it, and not provide them with a straight listing that they might then interpret in a manner that we believe to be not appropriate," according to one message.

The case was ultimately settled for an undisclosed amount of money.

Myocarditis

Myocarditis has been occurring at higher-than-expected rates in the United States in many age groups, especially young males, following COVID-19 vaccination. The condition is serious and has led to deaths.

A connection between the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines and myocarditis wasn't detected until after the FDA authorized them in late 2020. The vaccines, both of which utilize messenger RNA technology, cause the heart inflammation, according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and other experts.

At the time of the vaccine approval, the FDA said it was not able to "assess known serious risks of myocarditis and pericarditis and identify an unexpected serious risk of subclinical myocarditis."

"Therefore, based on appropriate scientific data, we have determined that you are required to conduct the following studies," the FDA said, listing six studies on heart inflammation and three for broader vaccine safety.

The one with the earliest completion date was the one that has been delayed. One study has already been completed, but results have not been released and the final report is not due until Oct. 31, 2023. The next earliest end date is May 31, 2024. Others are due in 2024, 2025, or even 2026.

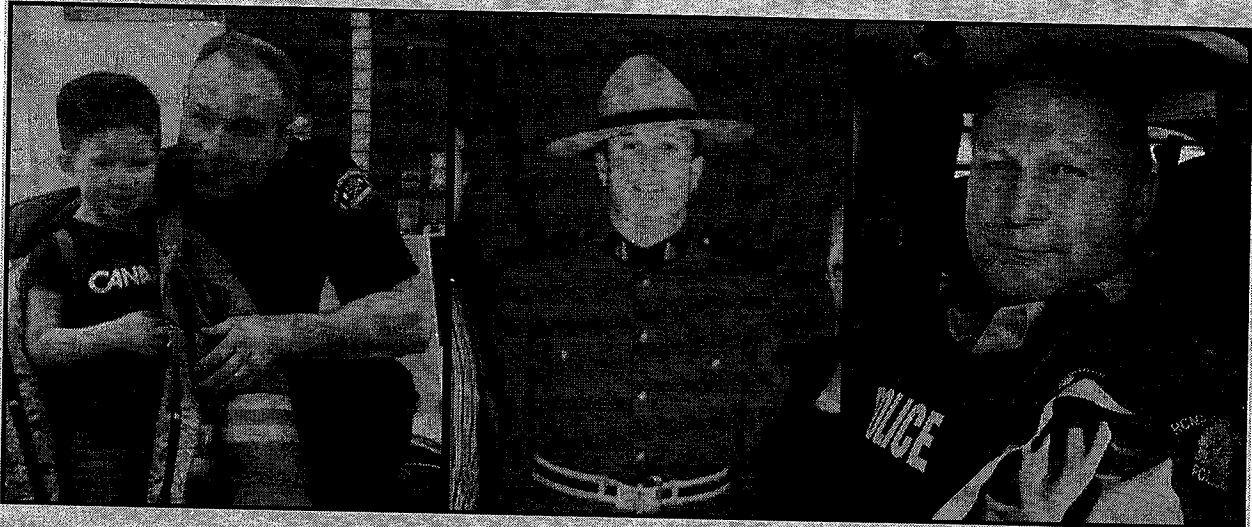

17-Year-Old Football Team Captain Rescued from Thailand Cave in 2018 Dies in UK

Deputy Ambassador Dave Thomas wishes Dom good luck with his studies and travels in the UK.

Wild Boars football team captain Khun Dom Duangphet Phromthep, who was one of the 12 boys rescued from a flooded cave in Thailand in 2018, has died unexpectedly in the United Kingdom.

The Zico Foundation, a Thai non-profit organization that funded Dom's football scholarship at Brook House College Football Academy in Leicester, confirmed his death on Tuesday.

"Zico Foundation would like to express our sorrow for the pass of Dom Duangpet Phromthep, a scholarship student from Zico foundation," the organization **wrote** on social media.

According to the **BBC**, the 17-year-old was found unresponsive in his Leicestershire dorm room on Sunday.

He was rushed by ambulance to Kettering General Hospital where he was later pronounced dead.

The teen's cause of death is still unknown, but police in Leicestershire have stated that they are not treating the death as suspicious.

Brooke House College principal Ian Smith offered his condolences, saying that the college community was "deeply saddened" by the news of Promthep's death.

"This event has left our college community deeply saddened and shaken," said Ian Smith, the principal at Brooke House college. "We unite in grief with all of Dom's family, friends, former teammates and those involved in all parts of his life, as well as everyone affected in any way by this loss in **Thailand** and throughout the college's global family."

"The college is liaising with statutory authorities and the Royal Thai embassy in London, and dedicating all resources to assist our student body, as they as young people process Dom's passing. Beyond that, we are unable to comment further at this time and would ask for privacy and compassion as we continue to support the students in our care at this time, drawing on the kindness and assistance of the Market Harborough community," he continued.

CNN's Don Riddell spoke with the 2018 rescue mission's lead diver, Rick Stanton, who said he and his colleagues were shocked to hear the news that the athlete had passed away at a very young age.

"When John Volanthen and I first found the Wild Boars at the end of a fraught nine day search, it was Dom who took the lead and wrote the first messages to the outside world," he **said** in an email.

"As a personal recollection, it was Dom whose unconscious body I swam with as I escorted him to safety on the second day of the rescue mission. I carefully held his precious life in my grasp, bearing the full weight of responsibility towards his survival through the most extreme of circumstances."

Cave explorer Vernon Unsworth, who was also part of Dom's rescue team, said, "Life is cruel."

'The sad thing is he was given the opportunity he wanted in life and now his life has suddenly been taken away,' Unsworth **told** The New York Times.

On Friday, the standing Committee on Health, Aged Care and Sport heard from Australians who have felt neglected or dismissed after they sought help for long Covid or the ill effects of the Covid vaccines.

The inquiry was told Amy Segdwick died "suddenly and unexpectedly" in her sleep in April last year after she experienced negative side effects from the Pfizer vaccine.

Her parents Sophie and Bruce explained their daughter was prioritised for the vaccine when Covid struck, after she became afflicted with an unknown neurological condition in 2019.

A young woman died months after receiving two doses of a Covid vaccine.

The 23-year-old sought advice on the best vaccine for her condition and was told with minimal discussion that she should select Pfizer, the inquiry heard.

The decision set off a "catastrophic" chain of events, her mother said.

"She fell off a cliff after receiving her Pfizer vaccines," Mrs Sedgwick told the inquiry.

Amy noticed she had numbness in her feet and became unbalanced over the month in between vaccinations.

After the second jab, the numbness spread up her legs and her limbs ached. Mrs Sedgwick said Amy had trouble standing and walking when they made an urgent doctor's appointment.

The doctor said Amy's worsening health could not be attributed to the vaccine.

"When we questioned the conclusion, we were firmly told we needed to let the vaccine theory go," Mrs Sedgwick said.

"We were sick with worry."

She told the inquiry her daughter's condition deteriorated rapidly, to the point where she was unable to stand, walk, write or cut up her own food.

Mrs Sedgwick's "strong, brave, resilient daughter" had to be hoisted into bed during "the extremely traumatic time".

She died in the early hours of April 2, seven months after receiving the vaccine.

"I know Amy would be here today living her wonderful life, but for receiving that vaccine," Mrs Sedgwick told the inquiry.

"Our initial concerns about the adverse reaction should not have been so grossly dismissed."

Dismissal by medical experts was a recurring theme throughout the inquiry on Friday as the committee heard from people living with long Covid.

Associate Professor at UNSW School of Clinical Medicine, Nada Hamad, told the committee she faced extreme difficulty in getting recognition and treatment despite her medical expertise.

"I was repeatedly not heard or dismissed," she said.

"People would look at me and say: 'You must be making this up'."

Professor Hamad told the committee there was a "reluctance to acknowledge what was happening" to her even though she could articulate her symptoms in medical terms.

Associate Professor Nada Hamad told the committee her life had been drastically altered by long Covid.

Part of the problem, she explained, was that doctors were not properly educated about long Covid or given the proper diagnostic tools.

"We have introduced a chronic illness into the system which we don't want to acknowledge," Professor Hamad said.

"We don't need the car speeding into oncoming traffic to crash (before we) do something. We need to do something now."

She rejected the Department of Health and Aged Care submission that people need to be given hope.

"I don't think it's about hope," the Associate Professor said.

"I think it's knowledge, it's empowerment, it's protection ... I want to be able to continue living despite the disabilities I've accumulated."

The lack of recognition and understanding surrounding the disease has led to many feeling hopeless and frustrated, according to members of the Australia Long Covid Community Facebook Group

"The lack of certainty, the lack of diagnosis is what causes the mental health issues," Mr Robin Austin said.

"Hope is in a vacuum. It is useless."

Administrators of the group told the committee that many members felt "neglected or forgotten" because of their "very serious, life changing condition".

The inquiry heard the collection of data was a persistent problem for medical professionals trying to understand the impacts of long Covid.

"You've got a new disease characterised by 200 different symptoms, with a range of tests that are being done in different ways in different places, looking at different elements of long Covid," Australia's chief medical officer Paul Kelly said.

"It's very complicated."

He noted medical professionals needed a clear definition of long Covid in order to diagnose patients and study the effects.

Professor Kelly told the long Covid inquiry that a federal long Covid strategy was being developed to tackle the issues of data collection and disease prevention and treatment.

"It's clear it's not only a health problem. This is a much wider issue for society," he acknowledged.

The strategy will not be finalised until the committee hands down its recommendations.

UNLV Football Player Ryan Keeler Dies Suddenly At 20-Years-Old

Yet another seemingly healthy young person has passed away out of the blue. The University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) announced Monday evening that defensive lineman Ryan Keeler perished at age 20.

His cause of death is unknown at this time.

Keeler was a sophomore player originally from Chicago and an academic All-Mountain West honoree who played in seven games for the Rebels last season.

The Las Vegas Review-Journal **reported:**

UNLV defensive lineman Ryan Keeler died Monday in Las Vegas. He was 20.

No cause of death was given in a news release issued by UNLV.

"We are devastated to have lost a member of our Rebel family," first-year football coach Barry Odom said in the release. "While I had the honor of knowing Ryan for only a couple of months, he already stood out to our coaching staff as an incredible person, student and teammate. Our condolences and prayers go out to Ryan's family as we grieve along with them over this tremendous loss."

Keeler, a 6-foot-6-inch, 275-pound sophomore from Chicago, played in seven games last season and had eight tackles and one sack.

He transferred from Rutgers before the season as a redshirt freshman. He was a three-star recruit after attending Nazareth Academy in Chicago.

"The UNLV family is in mourning today over the sudden loss of one of our own," athletic director Erick Harper said. "Our hearts go out to all of Ryan's family and friends along with his Rebel teammates."

Keeler was an academic All-Mountain West honoree, holding a 3.80 GPA in pre-business. He was named Rebel of the Week on Feb. 12 by Odom during the team's offseason training program.

Several current and former UNLV players posted condolences for Keeler's family on their social media accounts.

"Words are hard to come by this evening as we grieve the sudden and tragic loss of UNLV student-athlete Ryan Keeler," UNLV president Keith E. Whitfield said. "My sincere condolences are with Ryan's family, friends, loved ones and teammates during this very difficult time."

"My mom was personally affected, she lost feeling in her jaw and tongue and in her hands and feet. She has what seems to be some type of transverse myelitis," Slater continued.

Next, the surfer claimed the mother of one of his friends in Florida is "dying slowly" in a hospital from her vaccine injury.

"It's baffling to me that anyone would be forced to continue, **to be forced to have a vaccine to keep their career, their job, their schooling, their place in society, their ability to go buy food at a store. Healthy 22-Year-Old Woman Collapses During Lunch with Friends – Had 7 Cardiac Arrests over 11 Days – Experts Suspect Virus Caused Heart Inflammation

A 22-year-old woman from Eglinton, County Londonderry suddenly collapsed while out for lunch with her friends.

Aoife Boyle, who has no family history of heart conditions, suffered seven cardiac arrests in eleven days after collapsing during lunch with her friends in a pub last month.

“Aoife was meeting her friends for lunch at a pub, they just got in through the door, they didn’t even make it to sit down, and the next thing she just collapsed and started taking seizures,” Aoife’s mother, Tanya Boyle told **BBC News NI**.

“They rang me straight away, telling me to just get there quick.”

Ms. Boyle said she would always be grateful that Aileen McGuinness, one of Aoife’s friends, was a trained nurse.

Ms. McGuinness gave Aoife CPR until paramedics came.

Aoife was taken to the Royal Victoria Hospital in Belfast, and then she was airlifted to the Freeman Hospital in Newcastle, England.

Ms. Boyle added that her daughter suffered seven cardiac arrests and needed to be restarted every time.

“Within 11 days she had seven cardiac arrests,” Ms. Boyle told BBC News NI.

“Five of them she stopped breathing and they had to do CPR, two of them they didn’t have to do CPR but they had to sedate her to shock her to get the rhythm of her heart back.

“When we got to Newcastle, we were told her heart function was between 10 and 20%.”

Aoife told the BBC that she barely remembered passing out in the pub or being taken to the hospitals in Derry and Belfast.

“It was only when I got to Newcastle and I started on different medications,” she said. “I would have my good and bad days, but then reality slowly started to hit.

“I wouldn’t have been an anxious person before but I got really anxious, I didn’t let mommy out of my sight.

“The cardiac arrests would mostly happen when I was asleep at night so I was terrified to sleep.”

“Any doctor that we seen said I was a very lucky girl to be living, and we just can’t thank people enough,” she said. “I was leading a normal life, started a new job and was living like any other 22-year-old and then all of a sudden this happens. Life is far too short, that is the outlook you have to have when something like this happens.”

BBC News NI reported that Aoife’s doctors suspect she “may have caught a virus resulting in inflammation and excess fluid around her heart.”

She is currently recovering at home, where she is also wearing a defibrillator vest while she waits for additional tests.

"I would like to add the conduct of both teams' players is something you should both be proud of," the referee added. "Everyone did everything they could to try and help Michael."

Palmer's family described him as having a "strong sense of duty" and said, "With fervor and commitment, but with humility and confidence in equal measure, he inspired those around him to work harder, try harder, give a little more, walking alongside them and taking them with him on the journey."

The family added that it was "fitting that Michael's passing, notwithstanding the pain for those he leaves behind, was on the grassy velvet of the football pitch he so adored."

"Michael's loss will be forever felt," they said, "and hurt fades to scars, his light will shine the brightest in our galaxy of stars."

"We should take solace in this pain, that Michael will never be forgotten, and we will all remember his name."

Palmer's tragic death adds to the long list of healthy athletes suddenly dying since the Covid vaccines were rolled out.

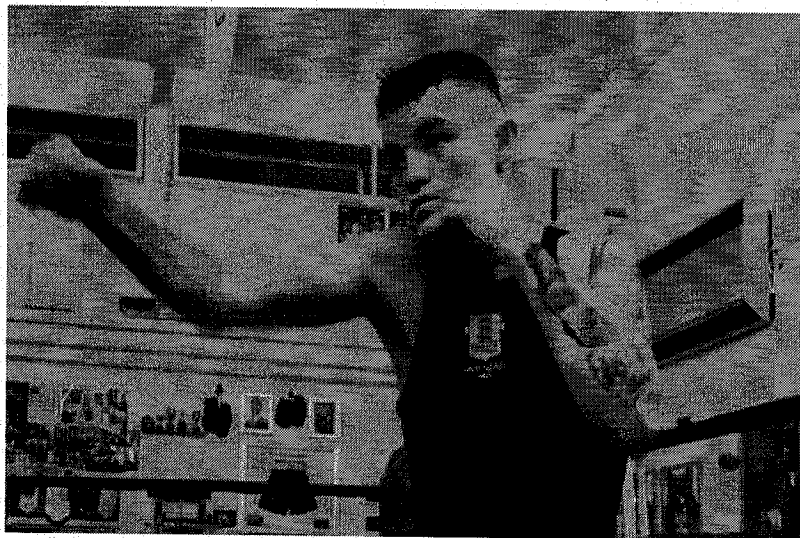
Since Covid vaccines were pushed onto the public, 1,800 people have collapsed and 1,200 athletes have ultimately died.

Downend Boxing Club exists for people like him," Head Coach at Downend, Craig Turner, said. "He was an absolute star, irreplaceable. Once you met him, you would never forget him," he continued. "I think he was one of those kids who was forever young and was just not meant to get old."

Turner continued, "Jude lived for his boxing. He lived and breathed it. I have never seen anyone with such an analytical mind and he could read the statistics of all the champions at all the weights."

"He was outstanding at everything he did and we are devastated. He didn't burn for long, but he burned very brightly for the time he did," Turner concluded.

A **GoFundMe** for funeral expenses states that his cause of death remains unknown.

"Jude was a highly talented, supremely fit 19 year old boxer who was tragically taken from us on 17 March 2023. His parents, Mark and Carla, and brothers, Ethan and Beau, currently have no answers as to what happened to this larger-than life character," the fundraiser states. "Whilst nothing anyone can say or do can lessen the sense of loss they and everyone who knew Jude feels, we can show them our love and support with a donation towards the cost of the funeral that should never have to be. RIP Jude Moore – once met, never forgotten."

College Football Player Comes Close to Death After Suffering Cardiac Arrest During Practice

Utah State wide receiver Josh Davis, who suffered a cardiac arrest during practice on Thursday, is no longer on life support.

Davis, who had CPR performed upon him by college staff after collapsing on the field, has had his status upgraded to fair condition, according to KSTU-TV.

The Deseret News noted that his cardiac arrest was labeled “non-traumatic,” meaning it was not brought about by any contact or injury.

“Awake, alert, and breathing on his own,” head coach Blake Anderson told Scott Garrard, who does the college’s play-by-play announcing.

“The training staff absolutely saved his life. No hesitation at all. Miracle,” Anderson said, according to the comment Garrard posted on Twitter.

Anderson also posted his own thoughts, writing, “it was a brutal night, but Josh never stopped fighting. Through God’s grace, and an amazing group of Trainers & Medical Professionals we are doing better ever minute today. So grateful for all the prayers & support lifted up over the past 24 hrs.”

Davis first went to Logan Regional Hospital and then to McKay-Dee Hospital, according to KSTU.

To preserve the athlete’s brain function, the hospital treated him with what is known as therapeutic hypothermia to keep down his body temperature.

Writing on Outkick, David Hookstead noted that other college athletes have experienced similar incidents.

“It’s an incredibly troubling trend nobody seems to have an answer to. What is causing so many young athletes in the best shape of their lives to collapse and suffer heart issues? That’s a question people need answers to and nobody should be afraid to ask for clarity on the situation,” he wrote.

Jackson State Football Player Hospitalized After Suffering Cardiac Arrest

A 21-year-old college football player has been hospitalized in Mississippi after going into cardiac arrest.

Kaseem Vauls, a defensive lineman at for Jackson State University, is being treated at the University of Mississippi Medical Center, according to local news outlet WLBT.

Vauls, whose Twitter bio says he stands 6 feet, 2 inches tall and weighs 270 pounds, was a red-shirt freshman who transferred from Alabama A&M ahead of the 2022 season. This is now his second season with the Tigers. According to The Clarion-Ledger, Vauls has not yet played a game this season.

Before college, he attended Irmo High School in Columbia, South Carolina.

On Wednesday afternoon, Vauls' father, William, said on Twitter that his son had been having stomach pains and went into cardiac arrest that morning.

Vauls had reportedly lost consciousness during that time and needed to be resuscitated by doctors, according to the Ledger.

William said his son later underwent an emergency surgery, which he said went well.

After that point, Vauls' health appeared to be "progressing" and William told the Ledger that he was in "stable condition, but still critical."

Vauls' father explained to the Ledger that doctors believe that heart failure caused a build-up of fluids throughout his son's body, which led to the stomach pain.

"His liver was suffering as fluid built up with toxins in his liver, kidneys and blood. All those toxins built up in his blood stream and his heart could not operate properly and the machine is being used to clean out the blood and toxins," William told the Ledger.

Despite experiencing this pain for about two weeks, Vauls continued to participate in activities with his team and didn't notify coaches or trainers of his pain, the Ledger reported.

When Vauls was ultimately hospitalized on Wednesday, a cardiologist told his father that Vauls' heart function was only around 10 to 15 percent, according to the Ledger.

Two more in the past week

In the past week, two high profile football (soccer for Americans) players have collapsed on the field of play, continuing a trend that has seemingly now become the norm.

Last Wednesday, 28-year-old Brazilian player Zé Carlos, from the club Ferroviário suffered a sudden illness while playing in a cup match.

He was treated as the game went on, according to reports, and returned to the pitch for a short time before being substituted and then collapsing and being taken to hospital in an ambulance.

Thankfully, the player was later released from hospital and is recovering.

In another incident in Spain, 25-year-old Serbian defender Dragisa Gudelj collapsed on the pitch, suffering a cardiac arrest.

Reports state that doctors performed CPR on the field reviving Gudelj. They treated him for seven minutes before taking him to the hospital.

Other players were left in a state of shock with some breaking down in tears. The game was abandoned after the incident.

The reports state that when Gudelj regained consciousness he wanted to carry on playing in the match.

The player is now "stable" but under "close surveillance" in hospital.

Gudelj's brother, who also plays in Spain sent out an update noting "The life of my brother, (his heart is) still beating, thanks to the medical services of Cordoba CF."

In addition to these two incidents, earlier this month, an Ivorian defender for RC Abidjan, Moustapha Sylla, was not so fortunate as he sadly passed away after collapsing during a league game.

He was just 21-years-old.

In Greece last month, a 20-year-old player from Karditsa **suddenly collapsed** without any contact with another footballer and later died in hospital.

Young Male Athletes Now Developing 'Turbo' Testicular Cancer – Are Covid 'Vaccines' To Blame?

Young men are dying at warp speed, compliments of covid injections

The *Belfast Telegraph* recently reported on the sudden death of Irish cricket player Daniel Donnan, 21, who had to be rushed to Ulster Hospital for treatment against a brain bleed. Medical tests further revealed that Donnan had tumors in his testes that had also then spread to his brain and lungs.

Just a few days later, Donnan was dead from the *warp speed* illness, which spread throughout his body and took his life unusually quickly, probably due to his having been previously injected for the Chinese Virus.

“Everyone is just completely devastated,” said Bangor Bowling Club secretary Thomas Cannavan about Donnan’s sudden death. “We still can’t believe it. This all happened in a matter of days.”

Donnan is hardly the only young male athlete who in recent days was diagnosed with turbo testicular cancer. Another is former Norwegian ski star Aksel Svindal who as of this writing is still alive following a successful operation – because he apparently caught the cancer early.

Then there is Hertha Berlin’s Jean-Paul Boëtius who was diagnosed with testicular cancer following a urological examination. Boëtius was joined by Timo Baumgartl, Marco Richter, and VBV’s Sebastien Haller, all four of whom are under the age of 30 and were also diagnosed with testicular cancer last year.

Other young male athletes who developed testicular cancer either this year or last include:

- MK Dons goalkeeping coach and former player Lewis Price, 38, who was granted indefinite leave from the league following his diagnosis
- Greater Western Sydney striker Bobby Hill, 22, who underwent surgery for testicular cancer and was left “indefinitely incapacitated”
- Young Norwich goalkeeper Dan Barden who was recently diagnosed with testicular cancer

The Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) also includes a report about a 32-year-old military man who developed testicular pain four days after getting his second dose of Pfizer – BioNTech’s mRNA (messenger RNA) injection. Twenty days later, the serviceman was diagnosed with testicular cancer that had metastasized to his retroperitoneal lymph nodes.

“As an oncologist, I ask how and why,” Makis wrote. “Yes, the COVID-19 vaccine spike protein localizes to the testes, according to the Japanese Pfizer Organ bio-distribution study done with rats. But at 48hr, the ovaries get 40x more LNP-mRNA than testes.”
