Teen Dies After Medical Emergency During Swim Meet – She Was Just Days from a Big Accomplishment

A 17-year-old from Hawaii died suddenly after suffering a medical emergency during a swim meet May 13.

An EMS crew came to the aid of Tehani Kealoha and transported her to the hospital, where she was pronounced dead, KHNL-TV reported.

The cause of her death has not been released, according to that report.

Kealoha was a senior a Moanalua High School and had been scheduled to graduate the following Friday.

The teen, a member of the Kamehameha Swim Club, had been scheduled to take part in the girls' state high school water polo championship the day she was stricken, <u>Hawaii News Now</u> reported.

That event was postponed after Kealoha fell ill, according to the report.

Kyan Shigekane, a sophomore at Kamehameha Schools Kapalama High School, where Kealoha's brother attends, told the outlet, "Her death really affected everyone at our school even though she didn't go here.

"Of course they cancelled the game when they found out the news because everyone was just so affected by it. They couldn't play."

Two days later, Kealoha's team defeated Punahou to win the state championship and break their opponents' 13-year-winning streak, according to the report.

28-Year-Old Professional Basketball Player, Who Previously Blamed COVID Vaccine for Myocarditis, Dies of Heart Attack During Stress Test

Dominican professional basketball player, Óscar Cabrera Adames, 28, tragically died of a heart attack on Thursday while undergoing a stress test at a health center in Santo Domingo.

A stress test is a medical procedure designed to measure the heart's ability to respond to external stress in a controlled clinical environment.

Back in December 2021, Cabrera collapsed during a game in the Spanish Amateur Basketball League (EBA) at the La Albericia pavilion. He was carried out on a stretcher and subsequently diagnosed with myocarditis, a condition that can impair the heart's ability to pump blood.

 Following his myocarditis diagnosis, Cabrera said on social media that his heart condition had developed as a result of receiving two doses of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine, which was a requirement for his participation in professional sports.

"I got a damn Myocarditis from taking a f-cking vaccine. (I got 2 doses of Pfizer) And I knew it! Many people warned me. But guess what? It was compulsory or I couldn't work," Cabrera wrote.

"I am an international professional athlete and I am playing in Spain. I have no health problem, nothing, not hereditary, no asthma, NOTHING! I suddenly collapsed to the ground in the middle of a match and almost died," he added.

"I'm still recovering and I've had 11 different cardiology tests done and guess? They find nothing. I have no cholesterol, no fat, nothing! 7% body fat 93% muscle. When they give me the diagnosis, they tell me that I won't be able to play for at least 5 months until my heart goes down again and they can't give me that medicine," he concluded.

22-Year-Old Ex-Premier League Star Forced to Retire Early Due to Myocarditis

In a heartfelt and emotional announcement, Lars Dendoncker, a former Premier League star and Belgian professional footballer, revealed his early retirement from football at 22.

Citing a diagnosed heart condition, Dendoncker has opted to prioritize his health over his passion and illustrious career in professional football.

Last year, Dendoncker <u>wrote</u> on his Instagram, "I have been through tough times the past few months. Six months ago I was about to make a transfer to a new club. I did my medical and something wasn't right with my heart condition. I suffered from myocarditis. But I did not have many symptoms. I had to stop playing football for 3 months and undergo further examination. I am still waiting for some second opinions and will keep everyone posted on my future."

In an emotional new social media <u>post</u>, Dendoncker revealed his decision, explaining that his long-cherished dream of playing professional football has abruptly come to an end.

"As a child, I only had one dream. Become a professional football player. But my professional career and dream has come to a very early end," he said.

Dendoncker, who has played as a defender for Brighton and Hove Albion in the Premier League and on loan for St. Johnstone, further stated, "Because of my heart condition, I have decided to stop playing because of my own health. This was and will be the hardest decision ever in my life. But there is no going back and I have to look in the future. This will take time to process."

"I've learned a lot throughout the years and had to sacrifice a lot. So this really hurts. 11 years at the academy of Club Bruges where I made a lot of friends. 2 beautiful years with Brighton and a loan move to St. Johnstone where I made my professional debut," he added.

Dendoncker expressed his pain at the abrupt end of his career, stating, "I've learned a lot throughout the years and had to sacrifice a lot. So, this really hurts."

Grammy-Winning Singer Tori Kelly Rushed to Hospital After Passing Out – Doctor Finds Severe Blood Clots

Award-winning singer-songwriter Tori Kelly was rushed to Cedars-Sinai Hospital on Sunday night after she collapsed during a dinner outing with friends, <u>TMZ</u> reported.

Doctors have since discovered severe blood clots in her body, raising fears and concerns for her health. A source close to the situation has told TMZ that the situation is "really serious."

Kelly, 30, who has enjoyed a highly successful career in the music industry and won Grammy awards in 2019 for Best Gospel Album and Best Gospel Performance/Song, was reportedly enjoying a Sunday evening meal with friends in downtown Los Angeles when the incident occurred.

According to sources, Kelly's heart began beating at an abnormally rapid rate, leading to her collapse. Eyewitnesses stated that Kelly was unconscious for a while.

Friends, alarmed by her condition, opted to immediately drive her to Cedars-Sinai, which is renowned for its state-of-the-art medical facilities and care, rather than wait for an ambulance.

"We're told Tori's getting care in the ICU, doctors have discovered clots in Tori's legs and her lungs ... and are still working to determine if any clots are around her heart. The singer's been in and out of consciousness during her hospitalization," according to TMZ.

"It was really alarming at first because I've experienced injury throughout my career, but it's never been anything like this that could turn into something detrimental if it's not taken care of," he said.

Goodwin has been placed on the non-football illness list and will miss the start of Training Camp.

Goodwin is entering his 10th season in the NFL. He signed with the Browns in free agency this offseason after spending 2022 with the Seattle Seahawks.

The 32-year-old has played in 102 career games and has 187 receptions for 3,023 yards.

A tragic incident unfolded earlier this month when the young daughter of a Johnson & Johnson Covid-19 vaccine executive died suddenly following a bout of seizures.

According to her family, 10-year-old girl Kelsey Corinne Morand suffered a fatal brain injury following a seizure on July 3.

"Our 10 year old daughter Kelsey Morand passed away unexpectedly on July 3rd, 2023," reads a fundraiser in memory of Kelsey seeking to enhance children's services at a local soup kitchen. "She suffered a brain injury brought on by a seizure and the result was too severe."

July 5, 2023 – Princeton, NJ – 10 year old Kelsey Morand, daughter of a J&J COVID-19 Vaccine Executive Mike Morand, died suddenly from a seizure.

A friend of the family wrote in a Facebook post the girl was "in the pediatric ICU after an extreme seizure yesterday that resulted in her flatlining for 20 minutes. She has been intubated, and is continuing to have seizure.

Facebook screenshots circulating on social media show Kelsey's father Mike worked in an executive position at Johnson & Johnson and helped bring about the company's Covid-19 vaccine.

"Friends - Wanted to share a bit of gratitude," reads one Oct. 16, 2020, post. "I just started a new role at Johnson & Johnson as Director of Channel Strategy for Vaccines. First objective is to support the successful launch of our COVID vaccine, and I am extremely proud to play a small role in this unprecedented challenge."

A tragic Facebook update from Morand just earlier this month noted Kelsey had "passed away unexpectedly."

It's unclear if the child had received a Covid-19 vaccination, or if the seizures she suffered were in any way related to a vaccination.

In Oct. 2021 Johnson & Johnson began conducting Phase 2a trials on Covid jabs for adolescents aged 12 to 17 years of age, however, the FDA last month revoked J&J's emergency use authorization, effectively putting a halt to the company's Covid vaccine program.

While it was not mRNA-based, the J&J one-dose Covid jab became the subject of scrutiny following reports it was causing blood clots in patients.

Another One? Boeing Dreamliner Pilot Suffers "Fatal Cardiac Arrest" Shortly After Takeoff

In late January, US Sen. Ron Johnson (R-Wis.) <u>sent a letter</u> to Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Acting Administrator Billy Nolen and Office of Aerospace Medicine Federal Air Surgeon Susan Northrup shedding light on a concerning trend of individuals in the aviation industry who experienced medical events after receiving a Covid-19 vaccine.

"What steps has FAA taken or will FAA take to investigate whether Cody Flint, Hayley Lopez, Greg Pierson, Bob Snow, Wil Wolfe, and other pilots experienced COVID-19 vaccine adverse events?" Johnson asked.

The senator wrote, "Based on data from the Defense Medical Epidemiology Database, the whistleblower reported that the total number of diseases and injuries in pilots across DoD was 265 in 2016; 252 in 2017; 164 in 2018; 223 in 2019; 2,194 in 2020; 2,861 in 2021; and 4,059 in 2022. These increases in disease and injuries in pilots across the DoD over the last three years, and particularly over the last year, raise questions as to whether FAA has seen similar increases in disease and injuries in individuals in the aviation industry." This leaves us with the latest incident: a pilot in command of a Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner suffered a fatal cardiac arrest in the bathroom of a commercial flight from Miami to Chile on Monday.

"Flight LA505 (Miami - Santiago) diverted to Tocumen International Airport in Panama due to a medical emergency of one of the three members of the crew in command," according to <u>CBS News</u>, which obtained a statement from LATAM Airlines.

The airline continued, "Unfortunately, after landing and receiving further medical assistance, the pilot passed away."



Back in April 2021, Kelly wrote, "Am getting the [Johnson & Johnson] vaccine this [weekend]. Have zero qualms [because] have spent a life immersed in a media obsessed with fear mongering that is often irresponsible and untrue. Do what your doctor tells you to do and ignore everyone else."

Last year, Megyn Kelly shared on her podcast that her 58-year-old sister, Suzanne Crossley, had <u>died</u> suddenly from a heart attack.

"Something really sad happened in my family over the weekend," Kelly said.

"My sister died. She was 58. Her name was Suzanne Crossley, and she died suddenly on Friday of a heart attack."

"She hasn't been in very good health over the past couple of years. Like sort of one problem after another. So it was sudden and it was unexpected," she added.

"I got news of it after the show, and went right up and was there with my mom and my brother Paul and my nephew Brian, one of her three kids, when she passed. So it was really hard, it was extremely emotional. My poor mom, as you all moms and dads out there know, this is not the order in which this is supposed to happen. So in any event, we were all together over the weekend. I'm going back up there after the show today, and she will have her funeral tomorrow."

Kelly said that her sister's death made her realize the value of family and friends.

New Mexico State soccer mourns death of junior defender Thalin Chaverria

Chaverria was just 20 years old at the time of her death, having celebrated a birthday on July 2. Originally from Bakersfield, Calif., Chaverria was a huge part of NMSU's team that made the NCAA Tournament in 2022, starting 20 games on the backline.

"The sudden loss of Thalia has completely rocked our Aggie soccer families' world. T was an inspiration and rock to this team. She will be missed but not forgotten. Her spirit will be with us every day, on and off the pitch," Aggies soccer coach Rob Baarts said in a statement released by the school on Tuesday.

NMSU is making grief counselors available to its student-athletes through the Aggie Health and Wellness Center to assist them in dealing with the tragedy.

Chaverria was an All-WAC Honorable Mention selection at NMSU as a freshman in 2021. In high school, she was a first team all-Area selection at Frontier High School in Bakersfield.

An official cause of death was unknown as of Tuesday, pending the results of an autopsy.

Las Cruces police said on Tuesday that they are currently investigating Chaverria's death, but that at this time it did not appear to be suspicious or the result of criminal activity.

"I don't know. I mean, anytime there's a young person that has any kind of heart problems or strokes or things like that, I kind of point in one direction," said Smith, adding, "It just goes straight to vaccinations every time."

Smith revealed, "When my mom passed, right, she got sick immediately after getting her booster. She was fairly healthy, but she got sick immediately after that. So, she got her booster and was in a coma in like two weeks."

Smith further linked Pfizer's recent admission of increased stroke risk in people over 60 receiving their final booster to his mother's passing.



1,884 Athlete Cardiac Arrests in 2.5 Years, 1,310 Dead

In the past two and a half years, the number of athletes suffering sudden cardiac arrests and related issues has soared to alarming levels.

In early 2021, young athletes started suddenly collapsing with heart-related medical emergencies.

Since then, a staggering 1,884 cardiac arrests or other serious issues have been recorded among athletes. Unfortunately, **1,310 of those athletes died suddenly**.

Good Sciencing has been maintaining a non-exhaustive and continuously growing <u>list</u> of mainly young athletes who suffered major medical issues in 2021, 2022, and the first half of 2023.

According to Good Sciencing, all of the athletes on the list share one common factor: They suffered sudden serious health issues after receiving one or more doses of Covid shots.

As of April 2023, Good Sciencing had recorded 1,884 athlete cardiac arrests or serious issues since January 2021. There are another 55 cases that Good Sciencing is still investigating or awaiting further information.

Good Sciencing has yet to record and investigate more recent incidents such as the four New Zealand rugby players. These four rugby players, reported by the New Zealand Herald last week, are also an addition to Mark Crispin Miller's list.

Since January 2022, Crispin Miller has been recording "died suddenly" cases worldwide that are reported in corporate media in a particular week, according to The Exposé.

In his latest compilation, he recorded 57 New Zealanders who were reported as unexpectedly or suddenly losing their lives between 19 and 26 June.


It's important to note that Crispin Miller makes no attempt to investigate whether the incident is related to Covid shots. The list merely records relevant details as stated in news reports.

For example, a man in Auckland died after suffering a medical event while in police custody. Last Saturday, a man was taken into custody for unlawful interference with a vehicle. "The man was transported to the Auckland District Custody Unit, however, on arrival officers became concerned for the man's welfare as he appeared to be suffering a medical event," police said. Officers immediately transported the man to hospital but he passed away a short time later. "No age or cause of death reported," Crispin Miller noted.

In another tragic incident noted by Crispin Miller, a class 12 student of a school in Kolkata, India, died after collapsing on the campus. The girl suddenly collapsed after the assembly session around 9.30 am. "She was then attended by the school doctor who found her pulse rate to be very low," a police officer said. "She was declared brought dead when taken to the nearby Belle Vue Clinic." A case was lodged in connection with the death and the body was sent for post-mortem. "It's still not known whether the girl was suffering from any illness," the officer said. "It seems that she died of a cardiac arrest, but the exact reason behind her death could be known only after the completion of the post-mortem."

In Ukraine, a lawyer was killed in a "vaxxident" when he suddenly died at the wheel. According to local Telegram communities, an uncontrolled car rammed several parked cars in Odessa. The deceased is a high-ranking law enforcement officer of the city R. Bershavsky. No age or cause of death was reported.

In Russia, theatre and cinema actor Mikhail Lozhkin, died suddenly at the age of 36. The cause of death was not noted.

In Belgium, two soccer players "died suddenly."

Former soccer player and ex-Red Devil Cédric Roussel passed away on Saturday at the age of 45. He collapsed on a terrace in Bergen on Saturday, first aid was of no avail.

In Germany, on 21 June a truck driver was found dead in his cab. He had parked his vehicle in a parking lot on Tuesday evening to spend the night there. The parked truck with the corpse in the cab had been discovered by local residents, who alerted the police. The man apparently died during the night of a natural death, police said. No age or cause of death was reported.

His heartbroken girlfriend Nicha announced Jo died while they were cuddling, shortly after gifting her a custom made necklace with her name on it. Nicha posted on Instagram: "He was in my arms ... than this is just happening too fast ... 3 days ago he kept (saying) that he had pain in his neck ... we didn't really realise it until it was too late. If you guys were know him like I do ... he is the amazing and incredible person in this world."

In most instances, we only have circumstantial evidence of the rise in young and otherwise healthy people dying suddenly following the Covid-19 injections to allow us to speculate about the cause of death. Tragic News: Actress Succumbs to Assisted Suicide Following Covid-19 Booster Injuries

Katarina Pavelek, a Slovakian actress known for her work on Fox Sports Live (2013), The Mindy Project (2012), and Marry Me (2014), died earlier this month in Liestal, Switzerland following an assisted suicide.

The model and actress had received her Covid-19 booster shot a year ago, which she believed would enhance her immune system.

Tragically, Pavelek experienced significant health deterioration thereafter, according to Evie Magazine.

The outlet reported:

Like most people, Pavelek thought the jab would improve her immune system – instead, it did the opposite, and she suffered heavily as a result.

Pavelek was diagnosed with an incurable chronic neurological illness known as myalgic encephalomyelitis/chronic fatigue syndrome (ME/CFS), a long-term illness with a wide range of symptoms that affects daily activities. At times, this condition may confine people to their beds. ME/CFS can worsen if individuals with this illness overwork themselves. The model was also suspected to have respiratory ALS, a neurodegenerative disorder that weakens the muscles involved in breathing and swallowing.

According to **CDC**, myalgic encephalomyelitis/chronic fatigue syndrome (ME/CFS) is a disabling and complex illness. People with ME/CFS are often not able to do their usual activities. At times, ME/CFS may confine them to bed. People with ME/CFS have overwhelming fatigue that is not improved by rest. ME/CFS may get worse after any activity, whether it's physical or mental.

People with ME/CFS may not look ill. However,

- People with ME/CFS are not able to function the same way they did before they became ill.
- ME/CFS changes people's ability to do daily tasks, like taking a shower or preparing a meal.
- ME/CFS often makes it hard to keep a job, go to school, and take part in family and social life.
- ME/CFS can last for years and sometimes leads to serious disability.
- At least one in four ME/CFS patients is bed- or house-bound for long periods during their illness.

Pavelek publicly addressed her thousands of followers on Instagram on June 1, 2023, announcing her heartbreaking decision to end her life due to the severity of her illness.

"Hi guys, over last 10 days I became severely ill again homebound unable to do much. My body is too weak to fight this illness and I have no more strength so I made decision to end my life at Pegasos association in Switzerland. I was diagnosed with untreatable chronic neurological illness," Pavelek wrote.

"ME/CFS caused by booster jab on top of having suspected respiratory ALS. This illness made me disabled, unable to work or have social life and unable to enjoy life all together. Breathing have become more and more difficult and painful for me and my lung function has been declining. Thank you for all your friendship and support over last year," she added.

Pavelek expressed her belief that the booster jab she had received had been the catalyst for her deteriorating health.



"The booster jab I received over year ago destroyed my health, my body and my life completely. There is no other way to end my suffering other than the decision I made," she concluded.

Pavelek's experience is not isolated. She is one of the millions who have reported adverse reactions following the administration of the experimental Covid-19 vaccine.

COVID Vaccine Advocate and Popular Mexican TV Doctor Dies of Alleged COVID-Related Heart Attack

A popular TV doctor who is part of the "HOY" program, a Mexican morning television show, and COVID vaccine advocate reportedly died of a heart attack early morning on June 26.

Dr. Alfredo Victoria Moreno, 42, a vaccine expert, epidemiologist, and former candidate mayor of Puebla, Mexico died suddenly allegedly due to the "consequences of COVID-19," Governor Sergio Salomón Céspedes Peregrina confirmed during a press conference.

The governor stated that the medical doctor died of "natural causes" but did not provide further details. "A restrained, responsible man, who together with the entire Health Sector, from different fronts, helped save many lives," Peregrina said.

In addition to being a medical specialist in epidemiology, he formerly held positions as a director for the Red Cross and as an adviser for the Ministry of Health.

Visibly shocked, Raúl Araiza, co-host of HOY program, announced the untimely passing of Dr. Moreno on the show while pointing out that he died of natural causes.

"Well, we want to inform you that... obviously it shocks us all as a team because you are creating bonds and affection... our very highly esteemed collaborator, Dr. Alfredo Victoria Moreno, died of natural causes, it seems...". Later, it was revealed that Moreno died of a heart attack, according to a report from **Sdpnoticias**.

Earlier this year, the doctor revealed on his TikTok that he was hospitalized due to atrial fibrillation – a form of arrhythmia, or irregular heartbeat, in which the atria (the two small upper chambers of the heart) quiver instead of beating effectively.

In a rough translation, Dr. Moreno said: "Well, now it is our turn to be patients. We are here hospitalized for a process of arrhythmia in atrial fibrillation, in a sequel that I have been carrying from COVID. This is the third episode I have had. And well, we must understand that exposure to the virus and having a disease like COVID is highly inflammatory, where it affects both the heart cell, which is the myocyte, and also affects the layers of the heart, especially the pericardium, generating inflammation there. Pericarditis occurs. And all of that also likes, in that not with a cardiac rhythm, which is an atrial sleep fiber. So, today it is our turn to be on this side."

Dr. Moreno is a staunch advocate of the COVID vaccine. His social media are filled with **posts** urging the public to get the vaccine.

"For people over 50 and those who are immunocompromised, a second booster dose is certainly a great idea," said Dr. Moreno in one of his videos.
